Undergraduate students, graduate students, and faculty are invited to submit an abstract of 300-500 words for a poster session associated with the event. Posters will be on display and time will be set aside for conference attendees to view the posters and discuss them with the presenters.

### ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

While we encourage those who have presented at CDFS conferences in the past to submit an abstract, priority in the review of abstracts will be given to those who have not presented recently. **Send abstracts to [FeministConference@sage.edu](mailto:FeministConference@sage.edu) by Friday, November 17, 2017.** Please state whether your abstract should be considered for a poster or paper presentation. Also indicate if you would like your paper to be considered for a poster presentation if it is not selected for a paper presentation.
